Chief Master Sgt. Tiffany S. Sargent is the Command Chief for the “Can Do” 305th Air Mobility Wing at Joint Base McGuire-Dix-Lakehurst, New Jersey. She is the wing’s Senior Enlisted Leader and principal advisor to the commander and senior staff on all matters affecting the health, welfare, readiness and morale of all total force members assigned. She also provides guidance on the effective utilization, training and professional development of more than 2,600 personnel operating a fleet of KC-46A Pegasus and C-17 Globemaster III aircraft. The wing’s mission is to provide rapid global mobility for national security objectives, contingencies and humanitarian relief efforts worldwide through aerial refueling and airlift capabilities.

Chief Sargent entered the Air Force in July 2003, graduating from the personnel technical training school in October 2003, and has held a variety of leadership positions serving at the squadron, wing and headquarters levels as well as a Joint Task Force Operations Superintendent. She has significant joint, special operations, mobility and nuclear command experience and has deployed in direct support of operations Enduring Freedom, Iraqi Freedom, Inherent Resolve and Spartan Shield. Chief Sargent’s stateside assignments include bases and classified units in Louisiana, Texas, Florida, Montana and Arkansas. Prior to assuming her current position, she served as the 492nd Special Operations Wing Senior Enlisted Leader, Hurlburt Field, Florida.
