Colonel Jacqueline D. Breeden, is the commander of the 305th Air Mobility Wing, Joint Base McGuire-Dix-Lakehurst, New Jersey. As commander, she is responsible for the wing's fleet of KC-10 Extender and C-17 Globemaster III aircraft, providing global mobility support for national security objectives, combat operations, contingencies and humanitarian relief efforts worldwide through aerial refueling and airland capabilities. The 305 AMW is also responsible for two of Air Mobility Command's busiest aerial ports, ensuring uninterrupted flow of forces and material in support of ongoing global operations. She is also responsible for managing all air operations at McGuire Field and Maxfield Runway.

Colonel Breeden received her commission from the United States Air Force Academy in 1994, attended Intelligence Officer Training at Goodfellow Air Force Base, Texas, and served as an intelligence officer for two assignments prior to her selection for Joint Specialized Undergraduate Pilot Training at Vance Air Force Base, Oklahoma. She subsequently qualified as an Instructor Aircraft Commander in the C-5 Galaxy with assignments at



Dover Air Force Base, Delaware; Altus Air Force Base, Oklahoma; and Travis Air Force Base, California. She is a Command Pilot with over 2,400 flight hours in T-37B, T-1A, T-53A, C-5A/B/C/M and KC-10A aircraft.

Colonel Breeden served in numerous leadership and supervisory positions at the squadron, group, wing, and MAJCOM levels. These positions included Commander, Cadet Squadron Three, United States Air Force Academy; Commander, 22d Airlift Squadron, and Deputy Group Commander, 60th Operations Group, Travis Air Force Base, California; and Chief, Complaints Resolution Division followed by Chief, Inspections Division, Office of the Inspector General, Headquarters Air Mobility Command, Scott Air Force Base, Illinois. Most recently she served as Commander, United States Air Force Academy Preparatory School, United States Air Force Academy, Colorado.
