## **OEM Training Courses**

#### Office of Emergency Management Instructor Led Training Courses

The Joint Base Office of Emergency Management (OEM) offers a wide variety of courses to personnel across the installation. These valuable courses hosted by OEM vary from basic instruction on Sheltering in Place (SIP), to more complex tasks such as training personnel to be members of the Emergency Operations Center (EOC). Below is a list of some of the courses offered and a brief course description.

<u>Emergency Preparedness Liaison (EPL) Course</u> – Unit EPL representatives manage their unit's Emergency Management (EM) program and participate in base disaster planning and recovery programs. They are

and participate in base disaster planning and recovery programs. They are responsible for assessing the unit EM program and keeping the unit commander and personnel updated on EM related topics. This course will teach you how to start and maintain an effective unit EM program.

<u>Control Center Operations (CCO) Course</u> – The CCO course provides a focal point within the organization to monitor unit resources and mission capability and to coordinate their activities during disaster operations. This course instructs on how to properly staff and operate a unit control center should you be appointed and assigned to that function.

<u>Shelter In-Place (SIP) and Evacuation</u> – This training will ensure personnel understand the principles and execution requirements if directed to SIP or Evacuate. Using an all-hazards threat approach, personnel will be instructed on how to SIP for their own protection and provides details on evacuation protocols.

Emergency Operations Center (EOC) Course - The EOC course focuses on command, control and communications operations to recover JB MDL from any situation which degrades mission capability. The EOC is the MDL focal point for incident response resource requests and functional expertise. The EOC coordinates incident operations and support requirements with the Joint Base and provides liaison with off-base civil authorities and response elements. The EOC members are referred to as Emergency Support Functions (ESF) who coordinate with their unit control center, civilian local, county, state and other Federal counterparts to advise and support the Incident Commander. This course will provide you the tools to become an effective member of the EOC to include use of common terminology In Accordance with governing directives. Air Force Emergency Management Program: Senior Leader immersion this instructor-led training educates and equips installation senior leaders with the tools necessary to effectively implement the installation's EM program at their level. This includes organization and implementation of the AF EM program on the installation, the local policies, structure, and responsibilities IAW HHQ directives and the installation IEMP 10-2.

EOC Director
This instructor-led training consists of knowledge-based and performance-based objectives that provides the skills necessary to perform EOC C2 functions effectively during emergency and contingency operations.
